

- Bull sharks are identified by their stout, thick body with relatively small eyes
- Bull sharks like to swim in warm waters and are able to thrive in brackish (part fresh, part salt) water, salt water and in fresh water
- Bull sharks like to eat fish, sting rays other sharks and sometimes dolphins

FUN FACT: Bull sharks are able to move between salt and fresh water by switching

up their kidney functions!
