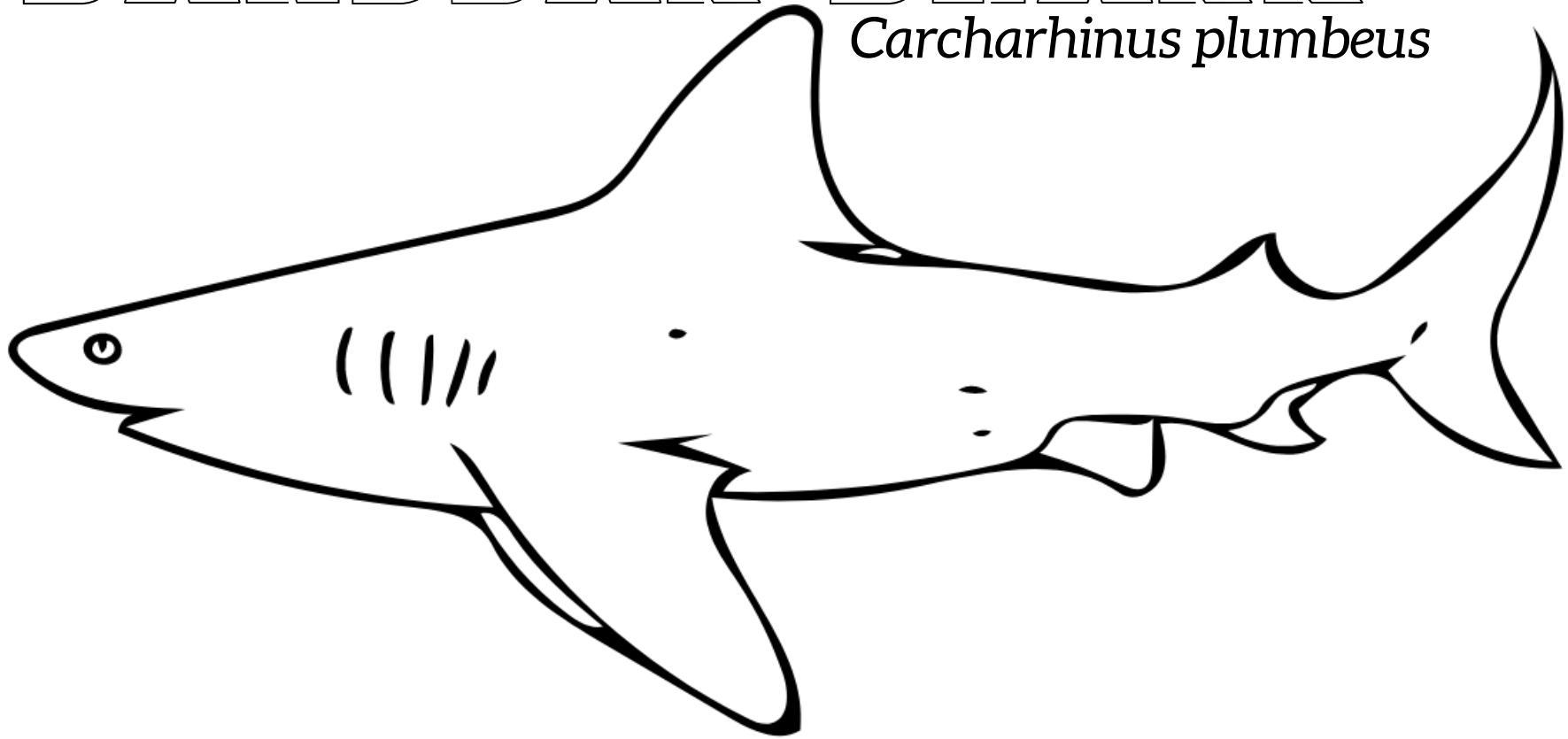


SANDBAR SHARK

Carcharhinus plumbeus



- Sandbar sharks are easily identified by their large first dorsal fin and pectoral fins
- Sandbar sharks are thought to be pregnant for 9-12 months and their litter sizes depend on the size of the mom and region
- Sandbar sharks can be found worldwide, often offshore on or near banks and deep reefs



FUN FACT: The US sandbar shark population declined 85-90% from overfishing so they are now prohibited from harvest!
